Dear Madam:

Since receiving your letter of the 29th ultimo we have gone carefully into the matter of the plates of your husband's books. We find that the plates of "Out of The Sunset Sea" and "Out With the Queen of Hearts" passed out of our hands some years ago. They were returned to Fords, Howard & Hulbert. All of the plates were acquired at an auction sale conducted by Bangs & Company in 1899. At that sale we bought a great many plates from the Cassell Publishing Company and it appears that some plates of the house of Fords, Howard & Hulbert were tacked on at the end of the sale. This is how we came to acquire the plates. "Pactolus Prime" was one of the books represented in the sale. We have these plates and it appears from correspondence with Fords, Howard & Hulbert that we made an agreement to print a paper edition from the said plates at a royalty of 10%, as you state in your letter. For some reason or other this edition was never printed.

As you have written us with the idea of acquiring
