Dear Madam:-

Your favor of the 14th received, and in regard to the markers will say that we can make them as reasonable for you as any local dealer and they will then be made of the same stock as your monument and will look better. I have an idea that you will want something plain so have sent you under separate cover two plain designs, but if these are not what you want I will send you others to select from. Number 10 and 13 are both the same price. Size 1.4 x 0.8 x 1.4 \$25.00 - Size 1 x 0.6 x 1.2 \$18.00 - Size 1.10 x .10 x 1.6 \$37.00. These prices include a cement foundation and the raised name on top.

In cities they do not allow us to set foot-stones, but I think they will at Mayville. They will cost you \$10.00 each in a size 8 x 3 x 10. These markers will be made of the best Barre granite.

I think it would be wise for you to send the remainder of the inscription and have it all done at once. It will be less expensive costing you at the rate of twenty cents per letter. The inscription you sent will be placed on the front of monument. Now do you wish a space on the front for yours, if so, please let me know in your next letter. Also in facing the front of the

monument. which side would you wish the remainder of the inscription on? We have the stock our for the monument and would like to hear from you in regard to the markers and also get the inscription correct.

I have sent the contract to the office, but just as soon as we get the inscription correct I will have them send you a copy of the contract.

Kindly return the designs sent you as soon as you are through with them.
