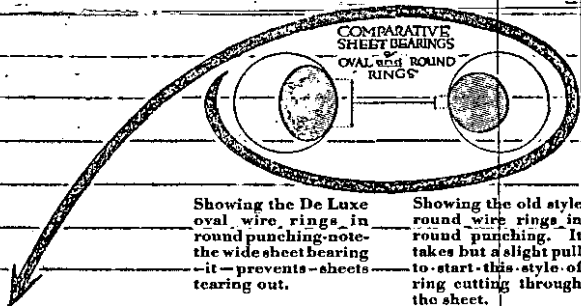


Why sheets don't tear out of De Luxe Ring Books

1—Because the oval wire rings give greater contact with the sheet at the punchings. Note the illustration below.

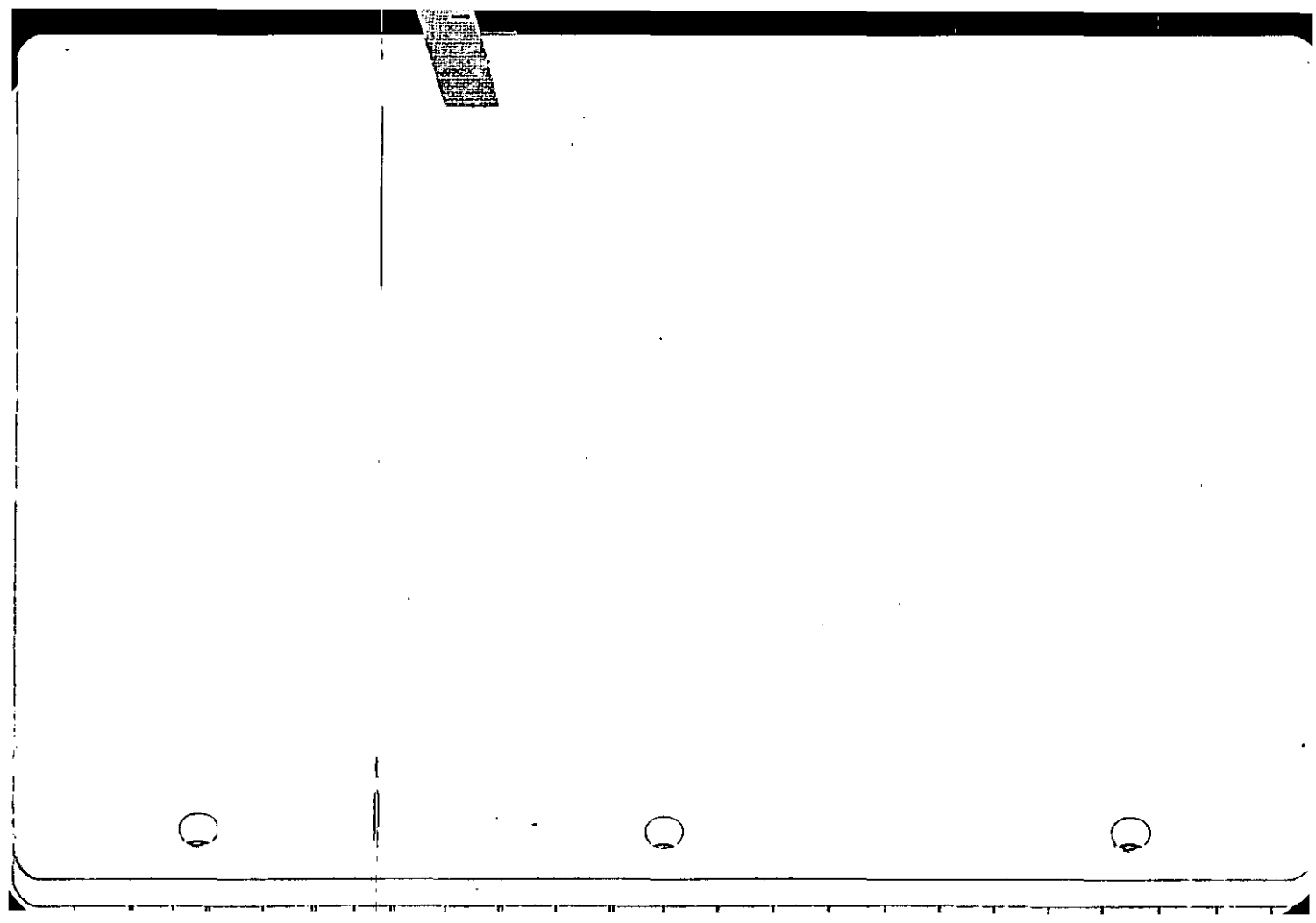

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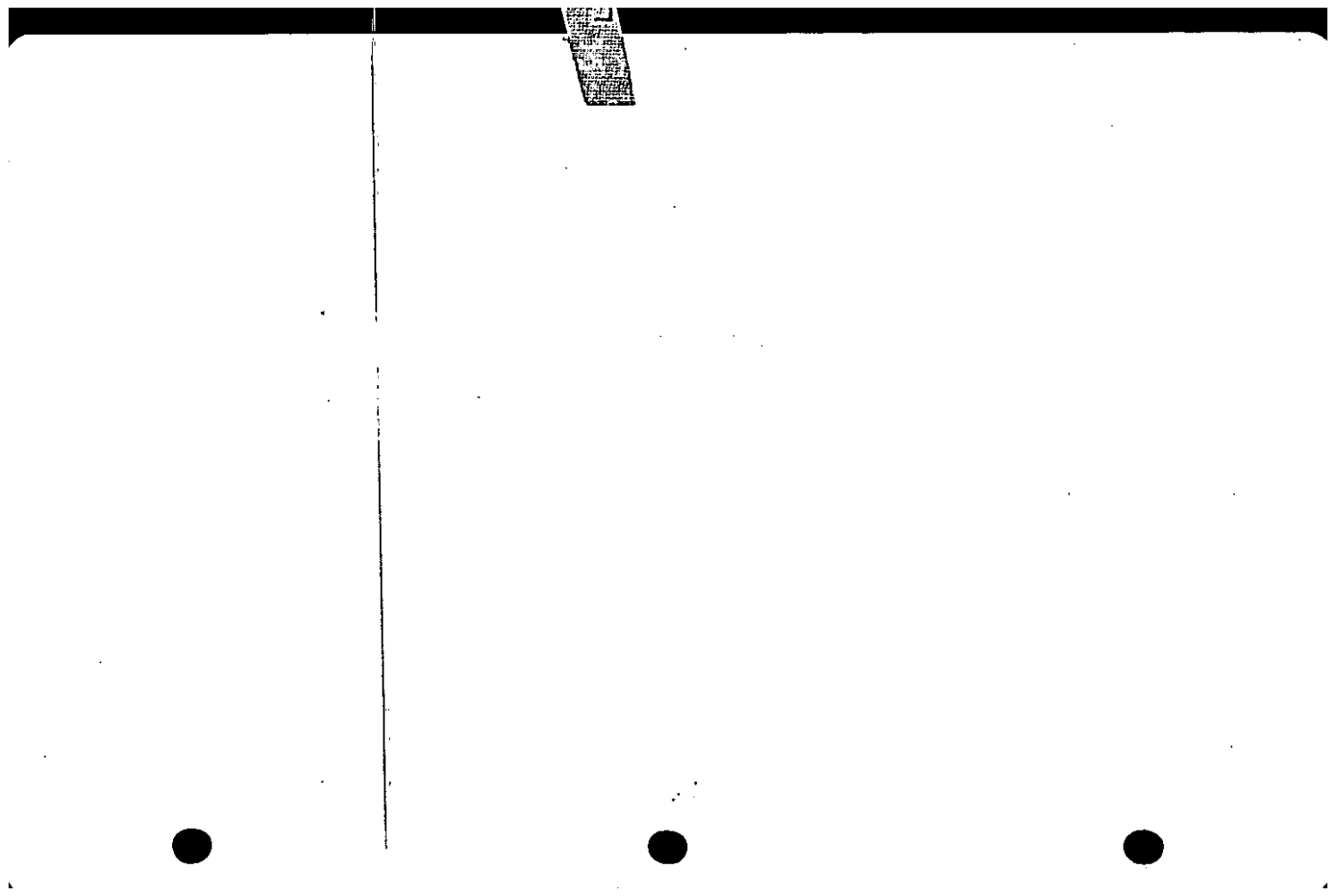

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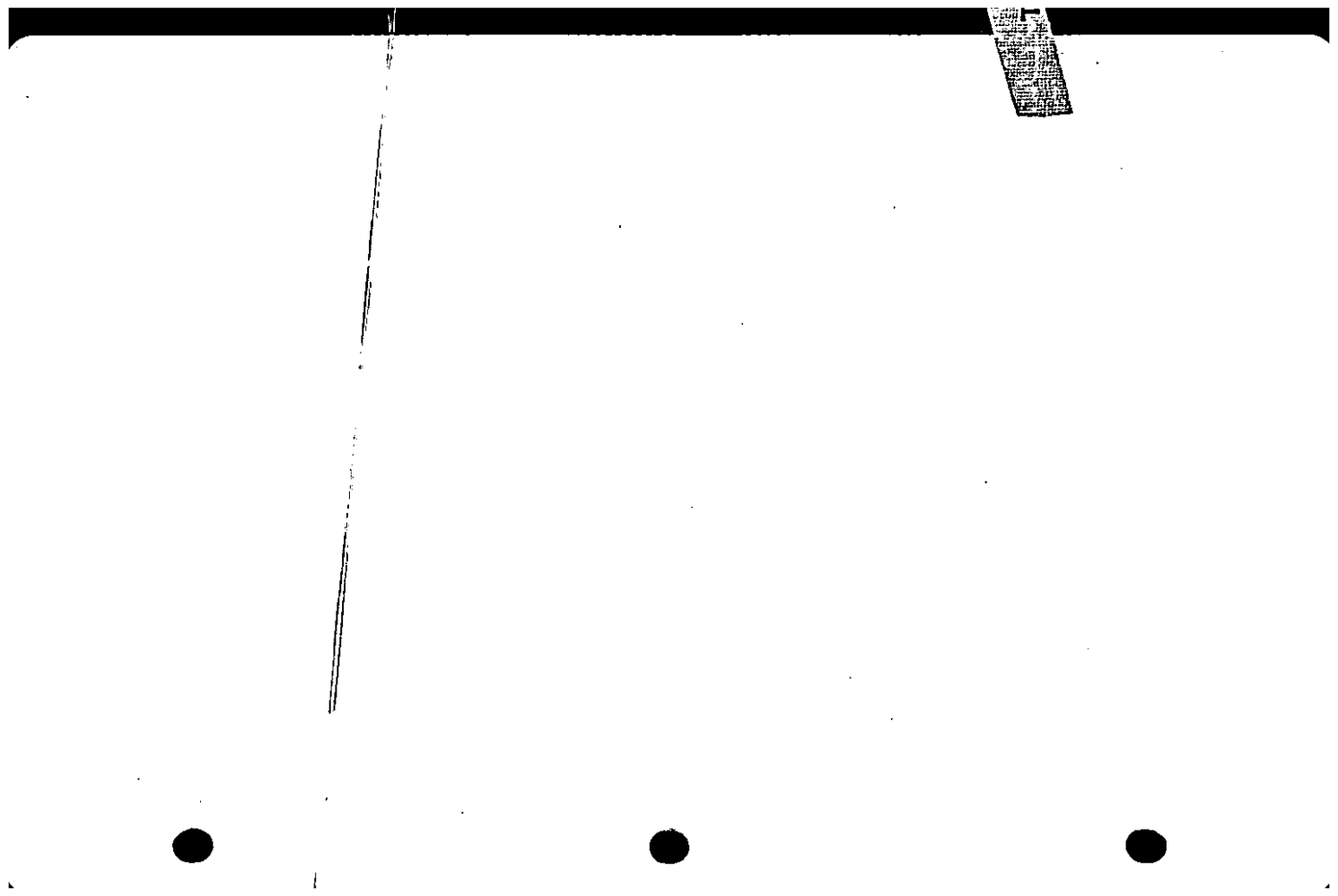
